May 26, 2007

Mottola completes comeback win for Chiefs

Chad Mottola sealed the comeback victory for the Syracuse Chiefs with a three-run home run in the ninth to beat the Pawtucket Red Sox, and end a five-game losing skid, 10-7. Russ Adams went 4-for-5 with four RBIs and fell just a double shy of the cycle.

May 27, 2007

Chiefs outslug PawSox to salvage series split

With a combined dominant pitching performance by Michael MacDonald and a potent offense, the Syracuse Chiefs slugged the Pawtucket Red Sox, 9-2. Howie Clark was a key part of the offensive explosion as he went 3-for-5 with four RBIs.

August 5, 2007
